

## St Monica's Catholic Primary School - Prayer and liturgy theme timetable (2023-2024)

Throughout the school year, year groups work collaboratively to prepare and plan prayer and liturgies across the week. We also have a Prayer and liturgy Assembly on a Tuesday morning for Key Stage 2 and on a Friday morning for Key Stage 1 with our Headteacher.

Weeks are colour coded in relation to the Liturgical calendar. We ensure that our holy tables based within each classroom reflect these liturgical colours so that the children can understand and appreciate the different periods in the churches calendar.

Each week each year group has their own theme based upon their work in Come and See. This allows the children to have additional time to build upon, explore and deepen their understanding of the scripture within the Come and See programme. We then have our whole school theme which each class year group can explore and plan and these focus on and include areas of Catholic Social teaching. Finally, the Wednesday word theme which uses the 'Wednesday Word' so that the children have the opportunity to explore the scripture that is shared in our Church that week.

Themes are followed by the Year groups, but scripture links are there as guidance and other scripture can be used if the teacher or leader wishes. Scripture used for Prayer and liturgy is from the following sources:

- Come and See website
- The Rainbow Good News Bible
- The Children's bible

- God's story 1, 2 and 3.

Alongside Prayer and liturgy, teachers ensure that daily prayers are being said, saint days are addressed when appropriate and important days on the liturgical calendar are also recognised.

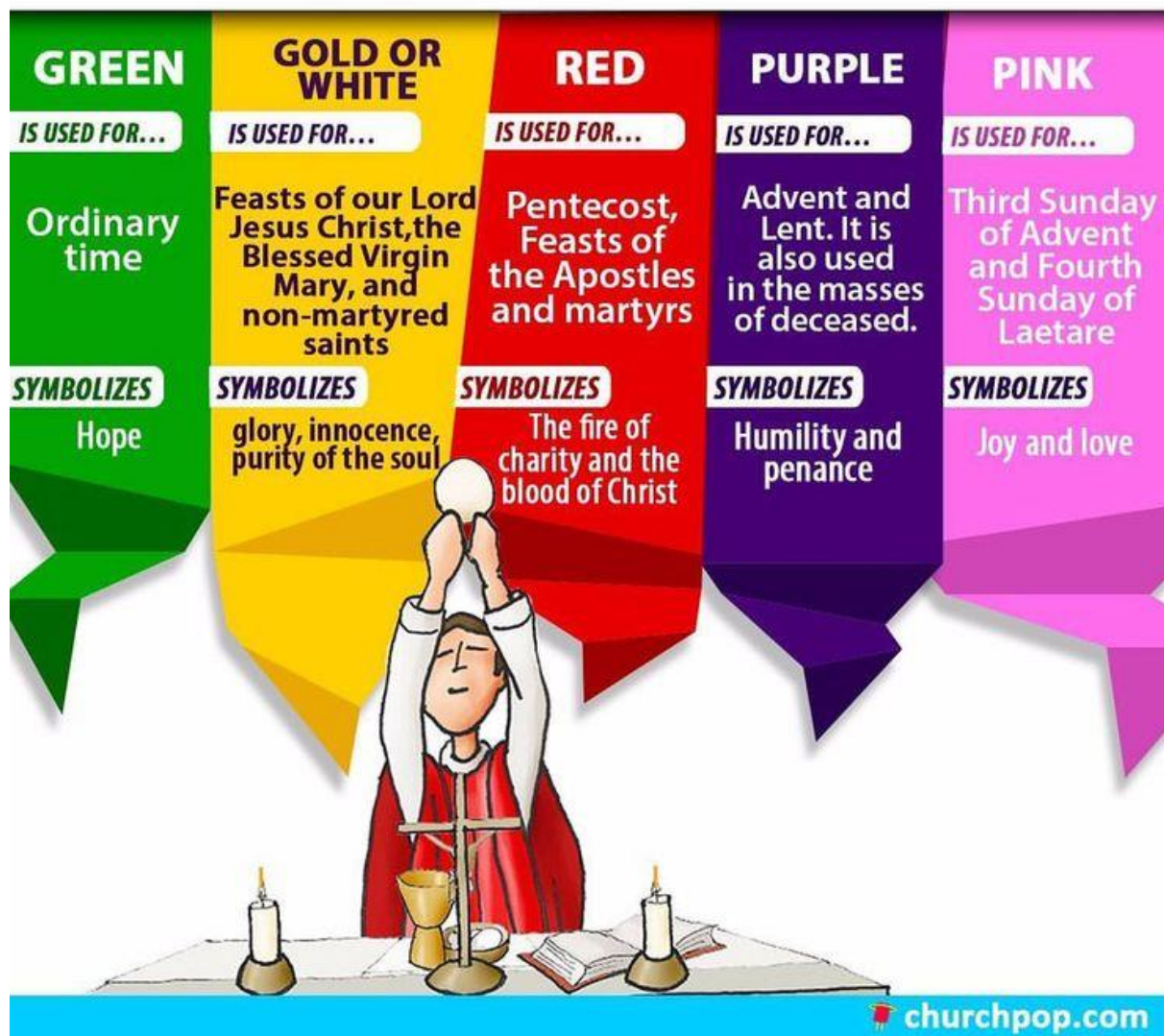
