Key Information

- **Wednesday 3rd July:** Children should be in at normal time for school, bags will be taken straight to the hall, travel in PE Kit. We will eat a packed lunch in school and then leave at 1:00pm: arrive, take bags to storage room, eat second half of packed lunch; afternoon activities, then evening meal and then evening activities (campfire)
- Thursday 4th July: Full day of awesome activities
- **Friday 5th July:** Breakfast, two activities, lunch and leave at 1:30pm. We will keep you all updated with return times via texts, pupils will be taken to the Junior Yard and dismissed from there.

Lunch Prior to Leaving

- All children will require a packed lunch for Wednesday families can pack two sandwiches so pupils can have a snack when we arrive, lunch will be at six o'clock
- Any children entitled to free school meals can have a packed lunch prepared for them by the school, but you may prefer to make your own. Please let us know as soon as possible.

Accommodation

- Colomendy has standard dormitory-style accommodation. During their stay, the children will be sharing bedrooms. We will endeavour to place all children with at least one friend.

- Rooms range from 4 to 12 bed dormitories, with gender-separated bathroom and shower facilities and party leader rooms

close by.

- Sheets, duvets and pillows are provided for all guests.

Children ARE required to bring their own towels.

- Children are not to bring any food (including sweets) with them due to allergies and being potential choking hazards.















Activities

- The children will take part in a range of outdoor activities led by trained instructors.
 - Outdoors: Activities integrated into the stunning woodland, including three huge climbing and abseiling towers, high and low rope activities, a 3G swing, a 200 metre giant zip wire, and an exceptionally realistic caving system built into a natural rock seam.
 - Indoors: Spacious sports hall for team games, fencing and recreational activities.
 - Water Sports: Purpose built water sports lake for raft building, kayaking and canoeing.

Packing List

-	The children will be getting wet and muddy so please provide suitable clothing and do not go to the expense of buying
	new clothes.

-	We	would suggest that you pack 5 full changes of clothes as the children may need to change after activities.
		Two pairs of trainers (one old pair as possibility of getting wet/dirty)
		Sturdy shoes
		Clothes (we suggest layers and to avoid jeans – all to be clearly labelled)
		Slippers or slipper socks for indoors (optional)
		Waterproof outdoor coat
		Pyjamas
		Towels
		Underwear
		Basic toiletries – toothbrush, toothpaste, shower gel, hairbrush, (no deodorant or aerosols)
		Sun cream/sun hat (this is to be clearly labelled - children will need to apply their own sun cream)
		Reading book
		Bin bags for dirty/wet clothes
		Water bottle - reusable (clearly labelled)
