As part of our home-school links, we aim to keep you fully informed of the curriculum being studied by your children. This term Year 6 will be studying the topics listed in the overview below.

Year 6 - Term 1.1					
R.E.	Loving Children will learn about God, who never stops loving, and what is meant by the term 'unconditional love'.  Vocation and Commitment Children will gain an understanding of the vocation of the Priesthood and religious life.  Prayer and liturgy Children will have daily opportunities to reflect and worship, helping their spiritual and moral development.				
English: Reading	Story Session Novel: Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo  Pupil Reads/Reading Comprehension: Reading is delivered through daily reading sessions with a clear focus. Dedicated read time is given to specific genres and key skills. Children have the opportunity to read a variety of fiction and non-fiction using combination of 'reading for pleasure' books and levelled reading scheme books; both are used to promote fluency and enjoyment				
English: Writing	Children will refine and develop their writing skills - focusing on creating a setting description before then we their own narrative (adventure) based on Kensuke's Kingdom.  The children will complete their own independent writing before then deconstructing and learning the text acquiring the necessary tools, participating in a shared write and then producing and editing their final independent write at the end of the unit.				
English: SPAG	Grammar and Punctuation Children will study nouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs, pronouns and relative pronouns, determiners, clauses, conjunctions, question marks, exclamation marks, commas in lists, commas after adverbials and hyphens. Children will learn to apply their grammar to their writing.  Spelling Children will complete spelling for:  Revision of Year 5 patterns: -ough and -able/-ably, -ible/-ibly Revision of Year 5 patterns: -ant/-ance/-ancy, -ent/-ence/-ency Revision of Year 5 patterns: -tious and -cious Children will have two weeks to practise each spelling rule. They will have their own individual Spelling Frame login to support their practise www.spellingframe.co.uk				
Maths	Place Value Children will revise and learn numbers to 10 million, compare and order integers, round negative numbers  Addition.subtraction. Multiplication and Division Children will develop their knowledge of the methods for each of the four operations and use these to add, subtract, multiply and divide. In addition, children will revise factors, multiples and prime numbers before then learning cube and square numbers.  Times Tables Children will be encouraged to use Times Table Rockstars to support their knowledge and recall of key times table facts www.ttrockstars.com				
Science	Electricity Children will associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit. They will compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches. Children will also recognise symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.				
P.E.	Gymnastics Children will use compositional principles to develop sequences, build trust when working collaboratively, and receive and provide feedback to improve their performance skills.  Dodgeball Children will learn and improve skills such as throwing, dodging, and catching. They play independently, follow rules, and evaluate their performance to improve their game and team's performance.				
Design and Technology	Cooking and Nutrition Children will be working alongside 'Food for Thought' to learn about, taste and evaluate some traditional dishes. They will be following a recipe including a method for vegetable stew / scouse.				
Computing	Web Page Creation Children will look at the features of a good website and learn to create their own web page using Google Suite.				
History	Liverpool's Role in the Slave Trade Children will explore how Liverpool have contributed to the Slave Trade and understand the legacy it has left behind today.				
MFL - Spanish	Conversational Skills Children will consolidate their conversational skills and be able to have conversations about their family.				
PSHE	Being Me in My World Children will understand their fears and worries about the future and know how to express them. Children will learn that there are universal rights for all children but for many children, these rights are not met.
