Here are the final details for this Friday's Summer Fayre. Please follow these arrangements to make it a safe, happy and memorable day:

- On Friday the children can come to school in their own clothes
- **School closes at 1:10pm Juniors; 1:15pm Infants**
- Please pick up your child from the classes as stated lower down
- This year's stalls will be held on the junior and infant playgrounds. There will be our St Monica's café, sweet shop in the hall and ice cream stand just outside the hall opposite the prayer garden.

Pick Up Arrangements - please read carefully

1. Please remember: **Do not drive or park on Kelly Drive - there will be hundreds of people arriving and we need to think of our neighbours and the safety of our children.**
2. If you have given permission for your child to attend the fayre with another parent/carer (for example, if they will be supervised by another adult because you are arriving later or unable to attend), ***YOU MUST INFORM YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER BEFORE THE DAY OF THE FAYRE.*** This is vital so that the teachers can safely dismiss the children to their chosen adults on the day. Thank you.
3. Please note, there will **no SMASH or after school clubs on Friday.**

Dismissal arrangements:

EYFS and Infants

Nursery to Year 2 - pick up from car parkside classes at 1:15pm

- Nursery - dismissed from nursery door.
- Reception - dismissed from Miss Horder's class.
- 1T and 2M - dismissed from Miss Macdonald's class.
- 1H and 2C - dismissed from Mrs Chorzepa's class.

Juniors

Year 3- 6 will be dismissed from the car park exits by our Main Office at 1:10pm

- All Year 3 children – dismissed from Ms Gibbon's class.
- All Year 4 children – dismissed from Miss Thomas' class.

- All Year 5 children – dismissed from Mrs Mrs Gilbertson's / Mrs Birch's class.
- All Year 6 children will be dismissed from Miss McGiveron's class - please note, **all Y6 children** will need to be picked up at 1:15pm, including those with walking home permission.

Once you have collected your child/children, please access the Junior Service Road via Kelly Drive. We will then open the **Summer Fayre at 1:30pm**, from the **Junior Playground (Y4/5 gate)** thank you for your understanding.

Once you have been to the stalls and enjoyed the Fayre, your child can go home with you at any time as long as they are with their trusted adult.

A huge thank you to the Friends of St Monica's, who have been instrumental in planning this event over many months. It is a massive task and they have been magnificent. Also, many thanks to the parents who have been getting everything ready behind the scenes for the past few weeks.

Thank you to all for the kind donations and offers of help on the day.

Please remember, the Summer Fayre will be a **cash only event**, bring as many pound coins as you can. The grand prize draw for the gift voucher will be held at 3pm.

In summary:

- **Infants picked up at 1:15pm from exits on the car park side by the office**
- **Juniors picked up at 1:10pm from exits on car park side by the office**
- **Children can wear own clothes for the day**
- **Year 6 children with walking home permission still need to be picked up at 1:15pm, if nobody picks up they can only leave at 3:15pm**
- **You must let your child's teacher or the office know if another adult is picking up your child**
- **Summer Fayre starts at 1:30pm (access from Junior Service Road, Kelly Drive) and will last until approx 3:30pm - you can leave at any time**
- **There will be no SMASH or Year 1 & 2 football club.**
